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## Preface

## Committees

### Lustrum Committee

The Lustrum Committee, consisting of seven members. Merel Buiten took place as general member of the Board.

### Lustrum Trip Committee

The Lustrum Trip Committee, consisting of seven members. Fabiënne Geerling took place as general member of the Board.

### Ski Trip Committee

The Ski Trip Committee, consisting of six members. Pieter Wijers took place as general member of the Board.

Next to that, the Eurekaweek Committee was installed by the 39<sup>th</sup> Board of SHARE, during the Half-yearly General Assembly.

### Eurekaweek Committee

This committee consisted of four members. Merlijn Dries took place as a general member of the board.

On behalf of the 39<sup>th</sup> Board of SHARE I would like to thank you for your effort during the last year. It has been a busy (Lustrum) year with many activities that we could not have organized without your enthusiasm and effort. You made the activities of SHARE memorable! ## Working together with other associations

As conventional, SHARE was part of Interfaculty Rotterdam this year. During the academic year of 2021-2022 it was a partnership between I.F.A. ACE, B&R Beurs, Cedo Nulli, Faector, InDuplo, MaEUR, and SHARE. Together with these associations we organized an amazing boatgala. On top of that, Interfaculty Rotterdam also organized a party in de Huiskantine for freshmen students in the Eureka week.

Besides that, SHARE took place in the Overarching Council of Faculty Associations of Erasmus University (KORF), following tradition. This council consists of nine Faculty Associations. The following Faculty Associations are part of the KORF: I.F.A. ACE, Cedo Nulli, EFR, ERA, FAECTOR, JFR, MFVR, STAR and SHARE. Meetings with KORF gave a lot of possibilities to learn from other faculty associations. Monthly, the faculty associations came together to discuss several matters and problems. It has again been very valuable to keep such good contact with the associations in KORF.

Besides these collaborations, SHARE was part of the Nationwide consultative body of study associations related to healthcare sciences (LOBEG). LOBEG consists of study- and faculty associations with the same study subjects. It is a partnership between the following associations: Anguilla, Apollo, SHARE, MSV Santé, Salus, Sirius, Studiosi Mobilae, SV Helix, V.I.B.. The LOBEG offers opportunities for exchanging ideas on Board and association matters by meetings every six weeks.

## Activities

Due to our amazing committees, consisting of 48 dedicated SHARE-members, the 39<sup>th</sup> Board has organized many memorable, both online and offline, activities during the academic year 2021-2022. Below you will find information of the activities that took place this year.

### Openingsactivity – September 9th

Before the change of the Board, we organized a drink at our new local pub Vader Kleinjan. Everyone reconnected after a long summer and was excited to meet the new SHARE members. With a total of 46 people attending, it was a great first event for the 39<sup>th</sup> Board!
